Submitted manuscripts cannot be returned unless the author so requests, and provides a self-addressed stamped envelope.

FORM: Citations generally follow A Uniform System of Citation (14th ed. 1986) and Government Style Manual (rev. ed. 1973).

AWARD: The Journal sponsors the Barbara Nachtrieb Armstrong Award for Outstanding Advocacy on Behalf of Social Justice for Women. We hope that our continuing efforts in contacting and supporting authors have planted the seeds for volumes to come. We hope that our readers will also join us in our efforts to fill this void. It is our strongest desire that all of our collective voices will yet be heard.
